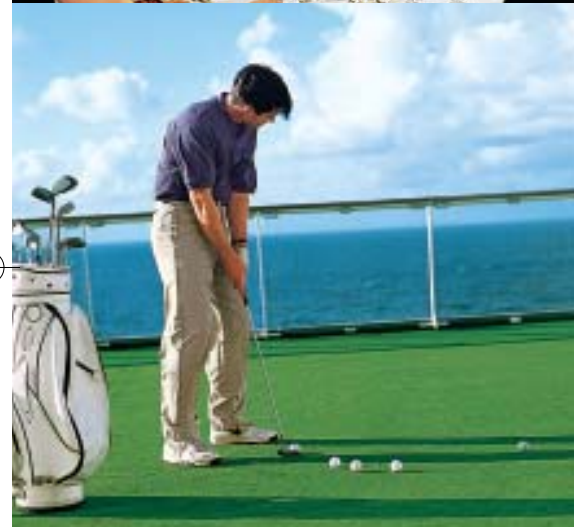

GUAYAQUIL, ECUADOR—Friday, January 19, 2007

After a typical Argentine lunch, drive through Palermo, a neighborhood of parks, gardens, mansions and embassies, to visit the Evita Museum.

DURBAN, SOUTH AFRICA—Tuesday, March 6, 2007

At the Sibaya Cultural Village, experience the colorful heritage of the Zulu nation. Your guided walking tour features demonstrations of courtship scenes, spear making and throwing, carving and pottery, before a visit with a Nyanga and Sangoma (tribal witchdoctor). The finale is a visit to the "Great Hut" for a live and interactive dance interpretation with storytelling. Experience close-up the thrill of the Zulu Coming of Age Ceremony. Afterwards, our lunch boasts a variety of typically South African fare with a Zulu overtone.

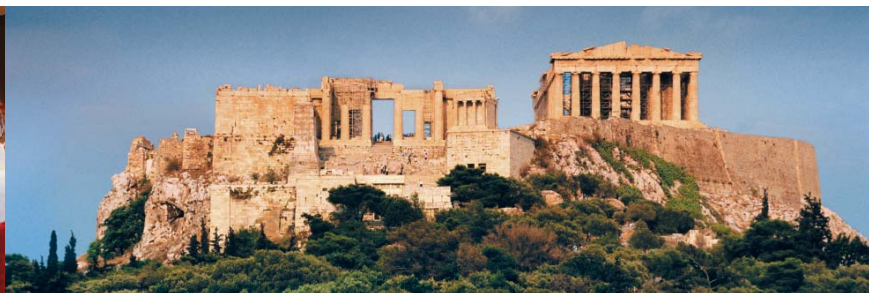
JERUSALEM & BETHLEHEM, ISRAEL—Sunday, April 1, 2007

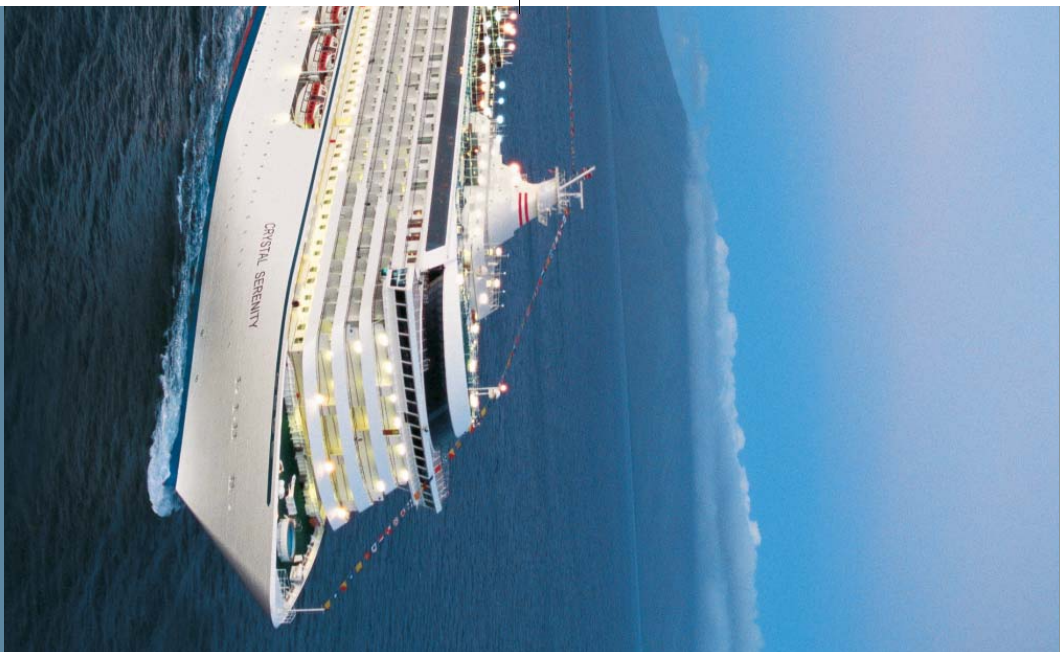
