Once back on land it's off to Capri Town. Your guide will escort you down narrow streets to the main centre, passing by Capri's main square, the famous "Piazzetta". This is a bustling tourist destination with superb old buildings, sidewalk cafés, and fashionable boutiques resting in the shadow of the cathedral and campanile.

Following lunch at La Cantinella, join your guide for a visit to the beautiful Augustus Gardens. The gardens, founded by Cesar himself, offer fabulous views of Faraglioni and the bay of Marina Piccola.

Meet again with your guide and transfer down to Capri pier by funicular to reboard your ship.

### MUSCAT, OMAN—April 14, 2007

Enjoy a fine introduction to Oman's capital, the country's political, economic and commercial hub, with its exciting mix of medieval, traditional and modern architecture and culture. Your day begins with a visit to the Grand Mosque, followed by a visit to the colourful shops of Muttrah Souq. Next is Bait Al Zubair, a private museum housing traditional Omani Heritage items.

A drive to the old city of Muscat allows us to admire the splendour of Al Alam Palace. Then we drive through Oman's exclusive residential area of Shati Al Qurum and arrive for a photo stop at the exquisite Zawawi Mosque.

At Bait Adan Museum—a local house—you will be greeted with Arabic coffee and dates. The head of the family will enlighten you to the lifestyle and long-established traditions from the past. Enjoy a sumptuous Indian lunch at Mumtaz Mahal restaurant, then head back to the pier to meet your ship.

### CASABLANCA, MOROCCO—May 10, 2007

Immortalized by the 1943 film, modern Casablanca is the economic capital of Morocco with wide boulevards, public parks and imposing civic buildings. Our tour begins with the breathtaking Hassan II mosque, which boasts the tallest minaret in the world. Next, we make a private visit to the Jewish Museum, with a lecture by the museum director, before a drive out to Rabat, a former imperial city. We then drive to Salé and enjoy a private visit to the Belghazi Ethnographical Museum, the country's most important museum of Arab culture. After a delicious Moroccan lunch, we explore the potteries of Salé. On our return, we visit Mohamed V mausoleum and pass by the Royal Palace en-route to Casablanca port.
